

Further instructions on filtering

You can filter the programs by location (state, region) or by the following categories:

- Youth Provide Service to Older Adults
- Older Adults Provide Service to Youth
- Youth and Older Adults Provide Services Together
- Intergenerational Shared Site or Campus
- Grandfamilies Support Program
- Reading-Tutoring-Mentoring-Educational Support
- Arts-Music
- Community Service-Volunteering-Friendly Visiting
- Community Gardens-Nutrition-Health
- Technology

Instructions are provided below.

In general, “YES” denotes that the program has that particular characteristic, and “--” denotes that the program doesn’t have that characteristic, or did not provide information for that category.

Filter by State or Region

1. Zoom in to the desired area using the zoom tool  in the top left corner of the map.
2. Press the  to zoom in, and the  to zoom out.
3. Similar to Google maps, you can drag the map by holding your cursor  down over the map.

-----OR-----

Filter by State or Region

1. In the sidebar on the left, click on the filter button 
2. Click on the plus button  next to the state category  **STATE** (50)
3. Click Unselect All [Unselect All](#)

4. Select the specific state(s) you would like to filter by

Filter by Program Type



1. In the sidebar on the left, click on the filter button



2. Click on the plus button  of the category you would like to filter by (i.e., “youth provide service to older adults” or “arts—music”)

3. Uncheck the “--” option  . Now the map only shows programs where “YES” is checked for the category you selected. If you would like to add another filter, repeat steps #1-3.

4. To clear all of the filters you have applied, scroll to the top of the filter window and select the *clear filter* [Clear filter](#) button in the top left corner.
